We are seeking professional live event photographers, with outdoor, lifestyle, and live performance capture experience.

A 501(c)3 non-profit, we bring this unique park space to life with more than 450 innovative and engaging educational, cultural, fitness and recreational programs each year. Our free programming creates new and exciting opportunities for tens of thousands of NYC residents and visitors to learn, grow, and experience all that Brooklyn Bridge Park has to offer.

We're seeking professional live event photographers to help us capture our diverse range of outdoor events - from large-scale festivals, to vibrant cultural, dance, and art performances, to fitness and recreation, and environmental education classes and programs. With each event, we look to capture a mix of both the full-picture scale and energy, as well as highlighting individuals celebrating and having fun on the waterfront, including candid style shots. Photographers should be comfortable working in both large crowds or small groups, comfortable working with subjects of all ages including children, and be able to help capture a diverse representation of our audiences.

Photographers will be credited in all uses of their work, including social media. Photos and all rights will be the property of Brooklyn Bridge Park Conservancy. Photographers would be expected to provide a batch of edited event photos within seven business days of the event, unless otherwise communicated/approved.

Please note this is a broad request for proposals to be considered for individual photography events this season. Each event to be hired on a case by case basis; bundles may be offered.

- Hourly rate or range*
- A familiarity with Brooklyn Bridge Park and being locally based is highly preferred
